**WATER STATIONS:** It's unlikely that someone will stand in line to order a water. You can encourage customers to drink responsibly by having water stations throughout your venue.



**OFFER FOOD:** Another great strategy to prevent overconsumption is offering people food. Whether that means pointing them to your food menu, bringing breadsticks by, or investing in a popcorn machine.



**DRINK SPECIALS:** Create signature drinks or drink specials with lower alcohol content and promote them. This can be a great way to move products and encourage responsible drinking by slowing people down.



**CODE OF CONDUCT:** Create a code of conduct that sounds like your most enthusiastic staff member or your most loyal customer wrote it. Post it and point to it to redirect uncomfortable and unsafe behavior.
